If needed the Commission will be available to make up kits for the artists.

Music in the Park: The project was attended by approximately 100 people. Because of the rental expense, the budget was higher than expected. We might look into a change of venue for 2022.

Art contest: Mike Bock is following up with distribution of check to high school student.
