Commission will find at least 28 artists to participate. Each artist will received \$250 which includes all materials to complete project . Adult artists will be contacted before high schools and/or junior highs.

DWA will handle all marketing and contacts to retailers

DWA will make payments to artists. Commission will supply names of artists and contact information to DWA. Artists will be allowed to add personal information on painting not to exceed 5” x 3”

Motion made Laurie Swanson and seconded by Mike Bock to support the Wheaton: Love where you live window painting project in conjunction with the Downtown Wheaton Association. Motion carried
