

RESOLUTION R-60-06

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF AN AGREEMENT EXTENSION WITH HALLETT MOVERS FOR CONTRACTUAL MOVING SERVICES FOR PHASE II OF THE LIBRARY MOVE

WHEREAS, the City of Wheaton, Illinois ("City"), is an Illinois Home Rule Municipality pursuant to the provisions of Article VII, Section 6, of the Illinois Constitution of 1970 and as such, the City may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs; and

WHEREAS, the subject matter of this resolution pertains to the government and affairs of the City and its residents; and

WHEREAS, the City had received a proposal from Hallett Movers of Summit, IL in accordance with Paragraph 3 (Term of Agreement) of the Agreement Between the City and Hallett Movers, dated December 5, 2005 for Library Move: Phase II; and

WHEREAS, the City Staff has reviewed the Library Move: Phase II proposal and finds it meeting the requirements set forth by the Library Director; and

WHEREAS, Hallett Movers has agreed to expedite the move in a manner conducive to the schedules of other service providers; and

WHEREAS, the City staff is satisfied with the quality and timeliness of services received from Hallett Movers and recommends extending the agreement to cover the Phase II move.


