

RESOLUTION NO. R-68-08

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PARTICIPATION BY THE CITY OF WHEATON IN THE PRESIDENT'S CITIZEN CORPS PROGRAM (THROUGH MILTON TOWNSHIP C.E.R.T.)

WHEREAS recent changes in the Department of Homeland Security, F.E.M.A. and I.E.M.A. regulations, as a condition to continued grant eligibility, require a local Citizen Corps to have a formal authorization from participating communities in the Citizen Corps Program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Wheaton has supported the efforts of the Milton Township Citizen Corps since its inception, and;

WHEREAS, the City of Wheaton has been pleased with the success of the Milton Township volunteers who have made the Citizen Corps and Community Emergency Response Team (C.E.R.T.) one of the most active volunteer groups in Illinois.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Wheaton, DuPage County, Illinois, that the Milton Township Citizen Corps, under the leadership of the Township Supervisor, is hereby formally authorized to continue its efforts to promote disaster preparedness, response and recovery under the auspices of the President's Citizen Corps Program; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that each and every one of the over 300 volunteers who have been trained and equipped by Milton Township are hereby commended for their patriotism and volunteer spirit in helping to foster the goals of Homeland Security.
