


RESOLUTION R-36-16

**CONSTRUCTION, USE AND INDEMNIFICATION AGREEMENT
RIGHT-OF-WAY (346 E. OAK AVE)
Street Name**

THIS CONSTRUCTION, USE AND INDEMNIFICATION AGREEMENT, made and entered into this 29th day of JUNE, 2014, among the City of Wheaton, Illinois, an Illinois corporation, located in DuPage County, State of Illinois ("City"), and MICHAEL + LISA SAMUELS ("Owner").

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the City is in possession of a right-of-way within the City limits of the City of Wheaton, Illinois, and legally described herein; and

WHEREAS, MICHAEL + LISA SAMUELS (hereinafter "Owner"), the owner of the premises located at 346 E. OAK AVE, Wheaton, Illinois, which property is legally described herein and is contiguous to a portion of the right-of-way; and

WHEREAS, the Owners would like to use a portion of the City's right-of-way for the purpose of constructing and maintaining a lawn irrigation system; and

WHEREAS, the Owners acknowledges that this Agreement is not an easement and does not vest them with any property rights or claims to any portion of said right-of-way.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AND HEREBY AGREED by the City Council of the City of Wheaton, an Illinois municipal corporation, and the Owner as follows:

1.) The foregoing recitals are incorporated herein as representing the intent of the undersigned and as substantive representations and covenants.

2.) MICHAEL AND LISA SAMUELS are the owners of property located at 346 E OAK AVE Wheaton, Illinois, legally described on Exhibit A attached hereto and made a part hereof.

3.) The Owners, for a consideration of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) and other good and valuable consideration as stated herein, are hereby authorized to use a portion of the right-of-way more specifically identified as that portion of the right-of-way 346 E Oak Ave, Wheaton, IL

_____ for construction of and use of a lawn irrigation system as depicted on Exhibit B attached hereto and made a part hereof. The installation and use of the lawn irrigation system shall conform to all applicable ordinances of the City. Those ordinances are material terms and conditions of this Agreement.

4.) The City retains the right to enter said right-of-way for any purpose to perform any work including but not limited to constructing and maintaining the City utility systems (watermain, storm and sanitary sewers) and other infrastructure. If the City performs any work within said right-of-way which causes damage to the lawn irrigation system, the Owners shall be responsible to repair the lawn irrigation system at their sole cost and expense. . The Owner hereby acknowledges and agrees that City its, employees and agents shall have no liability to the Owner for any damage, removal or other casualty to the lawn irrigation system caused by the City, its employees or agent regardless of the cause.

5.) The City may terminate and cancel this Agreement together with all rights and privileges granted hereunder, by notifying the Owners in writing at least fourteen (14) days prior to termination.

6.) Upon termination of this Agreement, the City may destroy, demolish, or remove any improvements placed upon the right-of-way by the Owners without liability.

7.) To the greatest extent permitted under Illinois law, Owners shall defend, indemnify and hold the City harmless from any and all claims, actions, causes of action, costs, judgments, injuries, property damage, expenses (including reasonable attorney's and expert's fees) which arise or may be caused by the negligence of the Owners, or Owners' agents, as a result of the design, construction, maintenance, use or abandonment of the lawn irrigation system described herein.

8.) This Agreement is not an easement. Should a court of competent jurisdiction construe it as an easement it shall be a temporary easement which shall expire 14 days after such construction.

9.) The provisions set forth in this Agreement and exhibit represent the entire Agreement between the parties and shall precede all prior agreements, contracts, understandings, promises and representations, oral or written, as it is the intent of the parties to provide for a complete integration within the terms of this Agreement. This Agreement may be modified only by a further written Agreement between the parties, and no modification shall be effective unless properly approved and signed by each party.

10.) This Agreement shall be recorded in the Office of the Record of Deeds, DuPage County, Illinois, at the expense of the Owners.

11.) The Owners obligations under this Agreement shall be joint and several.

12.) This Agreement shall be binding on the Owners, their sucesors, heirs and assigns.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Corporate authorities and the Owners have hereunto set their hands and seals, and have caused this instrument to be executed by their duly authorized officials and the Corporate seal attached here all on the date and year first above written.

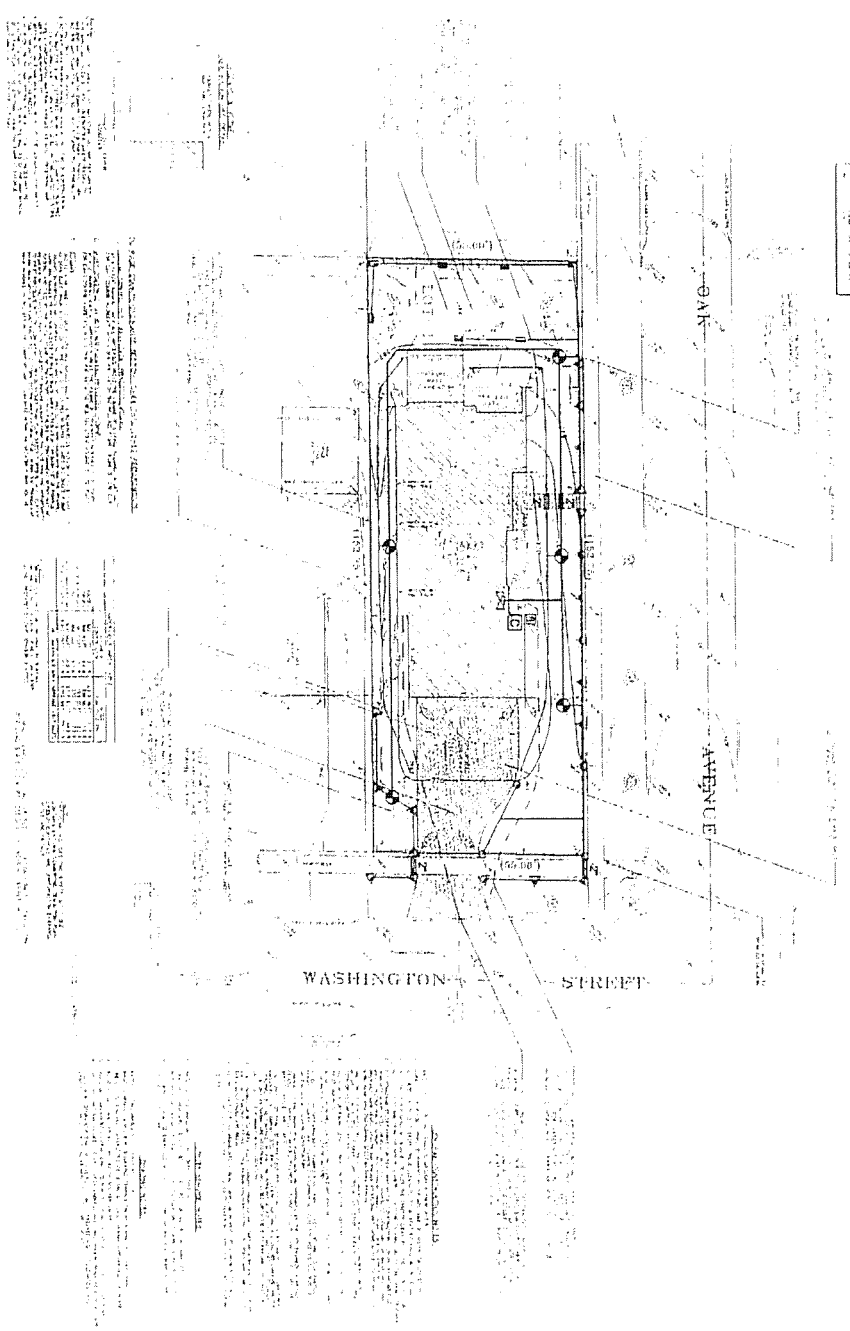

SYSTEM DETAILS

- This drawing is for departmental purposes only. Actual layout of sprinkler heads, valves, controller, and other equipment shall be determined on site.
- Sprinkler heads shall be installed in accordance with the area shown on plan.
- All materials and listed items shall be Class 200 PVC pipe, sized as shown on plan. Minimum listed size shall be 1" (All solvent weld pipe).
- All valves shall be Class 200 PVC. All valves shall be lock the original size of the pipe that they connect to.
- Directional boring or sawcutting for under pavement streets, if required, is to be provided by others.
- All fittings are to be solvent and Schedule 40 PVC.
- All irrigation lines shall be 115-13' covered burial U.P. mulchable. Wire to be placed in same trench as the controller shall be installed as directed by the owner. The owner shall provide 120VAC power to the controller's location.
- Conditions regarding flow rates, water pressure, system water supply point of connection (connection of the backflow preventer) to provide a point of inspection for compressed air to relieve the system of residual water in installation for winter shut-down of this system.
- All valves shall be installed on valves covered with green PVC.
- Valves shall be installed on valves covered with green PVC.
- All valves shall be 4" nominal height unless noted otherwise. All heads shall be installed on 4" nominal height unless noted otherwise.
- Ground electrical ground shall be installed on 4" nominal height unless noted otherwise.
