

ORDINANCE NO. F-0844

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE LIQUOR CONTROL ORDINANCE, CHAPTER 6 – ALCOHOL AND BEVERAGES

WHEREAS, The City of Wheaton, Illinois (“City”) is an Illinois home rule municipality pursuant to the provisions of Article VII, Section 6 of the Illinois Constitution, 1970, and as such the City may exercise any power or perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs; and

WHEREAS, the City has determined it to be in its best interest of the City and its residents to consider certain amendments to the Wheaton Liquor Control Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Wheaton, DuPage County, Illinois, pursuant to its home rule powers, as follows:

Section 1: That in Sec. 6-87. (19), the Class P License shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

“Class P license (seasonal market) shall authorize the retail sale of wine only in its original package and not for consumption on the premises at seasonal markets, provided that samples for tasting may be furnished. Applicants seeking a class P license shall submit for approval by the local liquor commission a detailed description of the physical layout of the location where the wine will be sold and a site plan for the seasonal market. The application fee for a class P license shall be \$100.00.”


Section 2: That in Sec. 6-129. Hours of business – Generally.

Information regarding the Class P License shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

“(8) P Permitted hours of operation are limited to the normal operating hours of the seasonal market.”

Section 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with these provisions are repealed.

Section 4: This ordinance shall become effective from and after its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form in the manner prescribed by law.
