

ORDINANCE NO. F-0895

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 6, "ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES" OF THE WHEATON CITY CODE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Wheaton, DuPage County, Illinois, pursuant to its home rule powers, that the Wheaton City Code 1996 as amended, is hereby further amended as follows:

Section 1: That Chapter 6, Alcoholic Beverages, Article III. Retail Licenses*, Section 6-87 – Classification of licenses, subparagraph (19) *Class P (seasonal market)*, is hereby amended by adding a paragraph, as follows:

“The holder of a Class M License shall be eligible for a Class P License upon submittal, to the local liquor commission, of a detailed description of the physical layout of the location where the wine will be sold and a site plan for the seasonal market. The holder of a Class M License shall pay an application fee of \$50.00 with no monthly fee(s) being required.”

Section 2: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with these provisions are hereby repealed.

Section 3: This ordinance shall become effective from and after its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form in the manner prescribed by law.
