

ORDINANCE NO. F-0901

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING APPENDIX B (FEE SCHEDULE) AND
CHAPTER 70 (TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES) OF THE WHEATON CITY CODE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Wheaton, Illinois, pursuant to its home rule powers, that the Wheaton City Code, 1996 as amended, is hereby further amended, as follows:

Section 1: That Appendix B, Fee Schedule, Article I. Administrative Fees, Section B-1 – Publication sales, subparagraph (4) (a), is hereby amended by deleting and replacing as follows:

“(4) Wheaton City code:
(a) Current copy . . . 125.00”

Section 2: That Appendix B, Fee Schedule, Article I. Administrative Fees, Section B-2 – Document sales, subparagraph (2) (b) and (d) are hereby amended by deleting and replacing as follows:

“(2) Maps:
(b) Zoning map, 18 inches by 24 inches 5.00

(d) Address map, 42 inches by 72 inches 10.00”

Section 3: That Appendix B, Fee Schedule, Article I. Administrative Fees, Section B-2 – Document sales, is hereby amended by adding the following subparagraph:

“(5) Media:
(a) VHS tape recording, each 20.00
(b) CD/DVD recording, each 30.00”

Section 4: That Appendix B, Fee Schedule, Article I. Administrative Fees, Section B-3 - Miscellaneous administrative fees, subparagraph (1) is hereby amended by deleting and replacing as follows, and subparagraph (1) (b) is hereby amended by deleting it in its entirety:

“(1) Conley Room Rental, per meeting 20.00”

Section 5: That Appendix B, Fee Schedule, Article I. Administrative Fees, Section B-3 – Miscellaneous administrative fees, is hereby amended by adding the following subparagraph:

“(15) Adams Park Rental

(a) Fee based on current rate for extraordinary police and public works services, 2 hr. minimum”

Section 6: That Appendix B, Fee Schedule, Article III. Public Works/Engineering Fees, Section B-23 – Floodplain, erosion control, site development and foundation fees, is hereby amended by deleting subparagraph (5) in its entirety.

Section 11: That Appendix B, Fee Schedule, Article IV. Fire Department Fees, Section B-32 – Fire investigation services, subparagraphs (1) and (2) are hereby amended by deleting and replacing as follows:

- “(1) Fire investigation report copy, per page . . . 5.00
- (2) Other investigation service documents, per page . . . 5.00”

Section 12: That Appendix B, Fee Schedule, Article IV. Fire Department Fees, Section B-35 – Photographic services, is amended by adding the following notation:

“Or actual cost, whichever is greater.”

Section 13: That Appendix B, Fee Schedule, Article V. Police Department Fees, Section B-37 – Administrative fees, is hereby amended by deleting this Section and replacing as follows:

“Sec. B-37. Administrative fees.

- (1) Bicycle registration50
- (2) Copies of police report, per page . . . 1.00
- (a) Copies of motor vehicle accident reports (2 pages) . . 6.00
- (3) Photographs:
 - (a) 8 x 10. . . 10.00
 - (b) 5 x 7. . . 8.00
 - (c) 3 x 5. . . 5.00
- (4) Freedom of Information Act Request (Report). . . 10.00
- (5) Solicitor decal . . . 1.00
- (6) Handicap placard . . . 2.00
- (7) Fingerprints (per person; applies to all persons including school district applicants & all non-city, non-law enforcement entities) 20.00
- (8) Fingerprinting-liquor licensing and new manager applications 100.00
- (9) Police certificates . . . 5.00
- (10) CD/DVD recordings (each). . . 30.00
- (11) VHS tape recordings (each). . . 20.00

(12) Audio tape recordings (each). . . 15.00

(13) Photographs from disk recording (per disk). . . 5.00”

Section 14: That Appendix B. Fee Schedule, Article V. Police Department Fees, Section B-39 – Miscellaneous fees, subparagraphs (2) and (3) are hereby amended by deleting and replacing as follows:

“(2) Wreckers or towing license, per year. . . 100.00

(3) Extraordinary police services, per hour, with a two-hour minimum. . . 46.00”

Section 15: That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 16: That this ordinance shall become effective from and after its passage, approval and publication in the manner provided by law
