

ORDINANCE NO. F-1006

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE OFFICIAL MOTOR
VEHICLE AND TRAFFIC SCHEDULES (CHAPTER 70)
FOR THE CITY OF WHEATON, ILLINOIS
(RESTRICTED PARKING)**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Wheaton, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That the Official Motor Vehicles and Traffic Schedule VII. (Parking prohibited during certain hours on certain streets) as referred in Section 70-354(d) of the Wheaton City Code, 1996, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:


- (17) Parking prohibited between the hours of 8:00.a.m. to 2:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, school days only.
- (j) Fanchon Street - east side – from Hawthorne Boulevard to the dead end.
 - (k) Purnell Street – both sides – from Hawthorne Boulevard to the Wheaton City limits north thereof.
 - (l) Farwell Street – both sides – from Hawthorne Boulevard to the dead end.
 - (m) Morse Street – both sides – from Hawthorne Boulevard to the dead end. East side – from Northside Park to Hawthorne Boulevard.
 - (n) Carlton Avenue – east side – from Hawthorne Boulevard to the southerly most point including the cul-de-sac.
 - (o) Hawthorne Boulevard – both sides – from Purnell Street to Morse Street.

SECTION 2: That the Official Motor Vehicles and Traffic Schedule VII. (Parking prohibited during certain hours on certain streets) as referred in Section 70-354(d) of the Wheaton City Code, 1996, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:


- (25) Parking prohibited between the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. Monday through Friday.
- (a) Hawthorne Boulevard – both sides – Gary Avenue to Purnell Street.

SECTION 3: That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4: That this ordinance shall become effective from and after its passage, approval and publication in a manner provided by law.
