

ORDINANCE NO. F-1054

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 6, "ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES" OF THE WHEATON CITY CODE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Wheaton, DuPage County, Illinois, pursuant to its home rule powers, that the Wheaton City Code, 1996 as amended, is hereby further amended as follows:

SECTION 1: That Chapter 6, Alcoholic Beverages, Article II – Administration, Division 2 – Local Liquor Commission, Sec. 6-56 is hereby amended by deleting subparagraph (a) of Sec. 6-56 in its entirety and replacing it as follows:

“(a) A local liquor commission is created, which shall be composed of five members appointed by the local liquor commissioner, subject to the approval of the city council, for terms of three years each. Members shall hold office for their designated terms and until their successors have been appointed. The local liquor commission shall have quasi-adjudicative powers for the purpose of hearing code violations.”

SECTION 2: That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3: That this ordinance shall become effective from and after its passage, approval and publication in the manner provided by law.
