## ORDINANCE NO. F-1065

## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE OFFICIAL MOTOR VEHICLE AND TRAFFIC SCHEDULES (CHAPTER 70) FOR THE CITY OF WHEATON, ILLINOIS

(THROUGH STREETS - NO PARKING)

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Wheaton, Illinois, as follows:

**SECTION 1:** That the Official Motor Vehicle and Traffic Schedule V. (Yield right-of-way intersections) as referred in Section 70-307 of the Wheaton City Code, 1996, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:

- (9) Reserved
- SECTION 2: That the Official Motor Vehicle and Traffic Schedule IV. (Through streets) as referred in Section 70-306 of the Wheaton City Code, 1996, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:
  - (82) Forest Avenue, at its intersection with Washington Street.
- SECTION 3: That the Official Motor Vehicle and Traffic Schedule VII. (Parking prohibited during certain hours on certain streets) as referred in Section 70-354(d) of the Wheaton City Code, 1996, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:
  - (17) Parking prohibited between the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, school days only.
    - (k) <u>Purnell Street</u> east side from Hawthorne Boulevard to the Wheaton City limits north thereof.
- SECTION 4: That the Official Motor Vehicle and Traffic Schedule VI. (Parking prohibited at all times on certain streets) as referred in Section 70-354(c) of the Wheaton City Code, 1996, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:
  - (92) <u>Purnell Street</u> west side from Hawthorne Boulevard to the Wheaton City limits north thereof.

**SECTION 5:** That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 6:** That this ordinance shall become effective from and after its passage, approval and publication in a manner provided by law.
