

ORDINANCE NO. F-1241

**AN ORDINANCE MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE
CITY OF WHEATON SPECIAL SERVICE AREA NUMBER SIX
FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING MAY 1, 2006
AND ENDING APRIL 30, 2007**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Wheaton, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1: Findings. The City of Wheaton Special Service Area Number Six has been created by an ordinance entitled, "An Ordinance Establishing the Wheaton Special Service Area Number Six", adopted November 1, 2004, and effective as of November 2, 2004, no petition having been filed opposing the creation of the special service area, pursuant to Public Act 88-455. Special Service Area Number Six consists of the territory described in the ordinance aforesaid. The City of Wheaton is now authorized to levy taxes for special services in said special service area.

Section 2: The following sums are hereby appropriated to pay the necessary expenses of Special Service Area Number Six for the fiscal period beginning May 1, 2006 and ending April 30, 2007, such appropriations being for the following objects and purposes:




Section 3: All ordinances or parts or ordinances in conflict with these provisions are repealed.
