

ORDINANCE NO. F-1535

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR AN ADVISORY REFERENDA/PUBLIC FUNDING WHEATON GRAND THEATRE

WHEREAS, 65 ILCS 5/3.1-40-60 grants authority to municipal corporations, through their elected officials to submit public policy advisory referenda for public vote; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Wheaton deem it reasonable and appropriate to place an advisory referendum related to the public policy question of whether the City of Wheaton should provide funding for the restoration and operation of the Wheaton Grand Theatre on the ballot of the general election scheduled for April 5, 2011.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Wheaton, DuPage County, Illinois, that:


SECTION 1: A public question shall be submitted to the voters of the City of Wheaton, in the County of DuPage, Illinois at the April 5, 2011 general election as follows:


“Shall the City of Wheaton use public funds not to exceed One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000.00) per year for the restoration and operation of the Wheaton Grand Theatre?”

SECTION 2: That the City Clerk, as the Local Election Official, shall certify the question in conformance with the Illinois Election code.

SECTION 3: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as authorized and directed to be done by the Mayor and City Counsel of the City of Wheaton.
