

ORDINANCE NO. F-1564

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE OFFICIAL MOTOR VEHICLE
AND TRAFFIC SCHEDULES (CHAPTER 70)
FOR THE CITY OF WHEATON
PARKING**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Wheaton, Illinois as follows:

SECTION 1: That the Official Motor Vehicle and Traffic Schedule VI (Parking prohibited at all times on certain streets) as referred in Section 70-354(c) of the Wheaton City Code, 1996, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:

- (23) Wheaton Avenue – West side – Roosevelt Road to Evergreen Street, Illinois Street to Liberty Drive, and Wesley Street to Jefferson Avenue. East side – Roosevelt Road to Illinois Street, Park Avenue to the school boundary south of Park Avenue, and Wesley Street to Front Street. Both sides – Front Street to Liberty Drive.

SECTION 2: That the Official Motor Vehicle and Traffic Schedule VIII (Parking time limited on certain streets and off-street lots) as referred in Section 70-354(e) of the Wheaton City Code, 1996, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:

I. On-street Limited Parking Time: In accordance with Section 70-354(e) and when proper signs have been erected, parking shall be limited to the maximum time indicated on the following streets or parts of streets between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. on Monday through Saturday, except legal holidays.

(a) 4 hour limit:

- (4) Wheaton Avenue West side – Evergreen Street to Illinois Street.
East side – Willow Avenue to Illinois Street and Union Avenue to Jefferson Avenue.

III. On-street Limited Parking Time: In accordance with Section 70-354(e) and when proper signs have been erected, parking shall be limited to the maximum time indicated on the following streets or parts of streets between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. on Monday through Friday, except legal holidays.

(a) 4 hour limit:

- (11) Jefferson Avenue Both sides – Gary Avenue to Main Street.


SECTION 3: That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.
