

ORDINANCE NO. F-1679

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 2 (ADMINISTRATION), ARTICLE V (BOARDS, COMMISSIONS AND COMMITTEES) OF THE WHEATON CITY CODE

BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Wheaton, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1: That Chapter 2 (Administration) Article V (Boards, Commissions and Committees), Division 13 (Historic Commission) of the Wheaton City Code, 1996, as amended, is hereby further amended by rescinding and repealing Division 13 (Historic Commission) in its entirety and replacing it with the following:

DIVISION 13. HISTORIC COMMISSION

Sec. 2-441. Established.

There is hereby established a historic commission for the city.

Sec. 2-442. Composition; appointment of members; term of office.

(a) The Historic Commission shall consist of nine (9) members appointed by the mayor with the approval of the city council for staggered terms not to exceed three (3) years. Members of the Commission shall be residents of the city of Wheaton. The commission shall elect its Chair, Vice Chair and Secretary annually.

(b) Membership on the historic commission will be composed of individuals knowledgeable in the historic traditions of the City and interested in the preservation of the historic character of the City. Persons such as architects, educators, historic preservationists, historians, museum professionals, real estate professionals and other community members whose interests and expertise will contribute to the enhancement and enjoyment of the City's heritage and historic structures.

Sec. 2-443. Purposes.

The purpose of the historic commission shall be as follows:


- (1) To promote awareness of the city's history and appreciation for the city's heritage among the citizens of the city.
- (2) To preserve and record the history of the city through whatever means are appropriate and feasible.
- (3) To provide liaison between the city and groups involved in historic preservation.
- (4) To recommend to the city council appropriate historic programs and projects.

Section 2: That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with these provisions are repealed.

Section 3: This ordinance shall become effective from and after its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form in the manner prescribed by law.
