

**ORDINANCE NO. F-1717**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 70 "TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES"  
OF THE WHEATON CITY CODE**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Wheaton, Illinois, as follows:

**SECTION 1:** That the Official Motor Vehicle and Traffic Schedule VIII (Parking time limited on certain streets and off-street lots) as referred in Section 70-354(e) of the Wheaton City Code, 1996, as amended, is hereby amended by repealing and rescinding Section I., paragraph (b), subparagraph (5) in its entirety and replacing it with the following:

- (5) Front Street Both sides from West Street to Wheaton Avenue, except two (2) mid-block spaces on the south side from 225 feet to 265 feet west of the intersection of Wheaton Avenue and Front Street; the first ten (10) spaces east of Cross Street.

**SECTION 2:** That the Official Motor Vehicle and Traffic Schedule VIII (Parking time limited on certain streets and off-street lots) as referred in Section 70-354(e) of the Wheaton City Code, 1996, as amended, is hereby amended by repealing and rescinding Section III., paragraph (b), subparagraph (2) in its entirety and replacing it with the following:


- (2) Front Street South side from Cross Street to Scott Street, except the first ten (10) spaces east of Cross Street.

**SECTION 3:** That the Official Motor Vehicle and Traffic Schedule VIII (Parking at night) as referred in Section 70-343 of the Wheaton City Code, 1996, as amended, is hereby amended by repealing and rescinding Section 70-343 in its entirety and replacing it with the following:


Except for physicians or operators of emergency vehicles on emergency calls and those persons receiving a temporary exemption, granted at the discretion of the Police Department, to allow for overnight guests or short-term construction, no person shall park a vehicle on any street between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. of any day; except on Wesley Street from Wheaton Avenue to Gary Avenue, no person shall park a vehicle between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 3:30 a.m. of any day.

**SECTION 4:** That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 5:** That this ordinance shall become effective from and after its passage, approval, and publication in a manner provided by law.
