

ORDINANCE NO. F- 1742

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE WHEATON LIQUOR CONTROL
ORDINANCE, CHAPTER 6 - ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES
SECTION 6-129 - HOURS OF BUSINESS**

WHEREAS, The City of Wheaton, Illinois (“City”) is an Illinois home rule municipality pursuant to the provisions of Article VII, Section 6 of the Illinois Constitution, 1970, and as such the City may exercise any power or perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs; and

WHEREAS, the City has determined it to be in the best interests of the City and its residents to consider certain amendments to the Wheaton Liquor Control Ordinance pertaining to the hours of business.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Wheaton, DuPage County, Illinois, pursuant to its home rule powers, that subsections (a)(1), (a)(3), and (a)(5) of Section 6-129 of the Wheaton City Code are hereby repealed and rescinded in their entirety and replaced with the following:

Section 1: That Sec. 6-129. - Hours of business – Generally, subsection (a) (1), is hereby amended to read as follows: Monday - Sunday, 7:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m.


Section 2: That Sec. 6-129. - Hours of business – Generally, subsection (a) (3), is hereby amended for a Class D, E and Q License to read as follows: Monday - Saturday, 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.; Sunday, 7 a.m. to 9:00 p.m.

Section 3: That Sec. 6-129. - Hours of business – Generally, subsection (a) (5), is hereby amended for a Class I License to read as follows: Monday - Saturday, 7:00 a.m. to 1:00 a.m.; Sunday, 7 a.m. to 12:00 midnight.

Section 4: All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict with these provisions are hereby repealed.

Section 5: This ordinance shall become effective from and after its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form in the manner prescribed by law.
