

ORDINANCE NO. F-2057

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING A CERTAIN PROPERTY TO THE CITY OF WHEATON,  
ILLINOIS - 2S527 WIESBROOK ROAD - SOLEM

WHEREAS, a written petition has been filed with the City Clerk of Wheaton, Illinois, requesting the annexation to the City of Wheaton, Illinois ("City"), of certain territory contiguous to the boundaries of the City and not within the corporate boundaries of any other municipality, pursuant to a proposed annexation agreement ("Annexation Agreement") which sets forth the terms and conditions under which annexation shall take place; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to notice, a public hearing was conducted by the City Council on December 11, 2017 to consider the terms and conditions of the proposed Annexation Agreement; and

WHEREAS, an annexation agreement dated December 18, 2017, among the City and Karen Solem ("Owner"), is the direct result of deliberations on the proposed Annexation Agreement pursuant to the public hearing and other meetings before the City Council and City Staff; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Wheaton, DuPage County, Illinois, pursuant to its home rule powers, as follows:

Section 1: The terms, conditions, provisions, and obligations contained in the Annexation Agreement are incorporated into this annexation ordinance by this reference as though fully set forth herein. A copy of the Annexation Agreement is on file in the Office of the City Clerk.

Section 2: The following described territory is hereby annexed to the City:

LOT 31 IN WIESBROOK'S SUBDIVISION, A SUBDIVISION OF PART OF THE WIESBROOK FARM IN THE SOUTHEAST ¼ OF SECTION 25, TOWNSHIP 39 NORTH, RANGE 9, EAST OF THE THIRD PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN, AND IN THE SOUTHWEST ¼ OF SECTION 30, TOWNSHIP 39 NORTH, RANGE 10, EAST OF THE THIRD PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN, ACCORDING TO THE PLAT THEREOF RECORDED MARCH 21, 1956 AS DOCUMENT 793559 IN DUPAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS.

The subject property is commonly known as 2S527 Wiesbrook Road, Wheaton, IL 60189.


Section 3: The City Clerk is directed to record with the Office of the Recorder of Deeds, DuPage County, Illinois, and to file with the Office of the County Clerk, DuPage County, Illinois, a certified copy of this ordinance together with the accurate map of the subject property appended to this ordinance.

Section 4: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with these provisions are repealed.

Section 5: This ordinance shall become effective from and after its passage, approval, publication in pamphlet form, and execution by all the parties to the Annexation Agreement approved in conjunction with the approval of this Annexation as in the manner prescribed by law.
