

ORDINANCE NO. O-2018-84

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE LEVY AND ASSESSMENT OF TAXES FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2019 AND ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2019, IN AND FOR THE CITY OF WHEATON SPECIAL SERVICE AREA NUMBER EIGHT

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Wheaton, DuPage County, Illinois, pursuant to its home rule powers, as follows:

Section 1: Findings. The City of Wheaton Special Service Area Number Eight has been created by an ordinance entitled, "An Ordinance Establishing Special Service Area #8 in the City of Wheaton, Illinois", adopted and effective as of November 19, 2018, no valid petition having been filed opposing the creation of the special service area, pursuant to Public Act 88-455. Special Service Area Number Eight consists of the territory described in the ordinance aforesaid. The City of Wheaton is authorized to levy taxes for special services in Special Service Area Number Eight.

Section 2: The total amount of appropriations for all the purposes to be collected from the tax levy of the current fiscal year in Special Service Area Number Eight is ascertained to be the sum of \$126,600.

Section 3: The following sums shall be levied upon the taxable property as defined in the Public Act 88-455, in the City of Wheaton Special Service Area Number Eight; said tax to be levied for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2019 and ending December 31, 2019.



Section 4: This tax is levied pursuant to Public Act 88-455 and pursuant to An Ordinance Establishing Special Service Area #8 in the City of Wheaton, Illinois.

Section 5: The \$126,600 tax levy is certified to the County Clerk of DuPage County, Illinois. The City of Wheaton determines this \$126,600 tax levy to be the total amount required to be raised by taxation for the current fiscal year of the City for Special Service Area Number Eight. The City Clerk of Wheaton, Illinois, is ordered and directed to file with the County Clerk of DuPage County, on or before the time required by law, a certified copy of this ordinance.

Section 6: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with these provisions are repealed.

Section 7: This ordinance shall become effective from or after its passage, approval, and publication in the manner prescribed by law.
