

RESOLUTION R- 2019 -06

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A DESIGN SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH PRIMERA ENGINEERING, LTD., FOR DOWNTOWN STREETScape PROJECT PHASE 3

WHEREAS, the City of Wheaton, Illinois ("City") is desirous of engaging the services of an engineering firm to assist the City with the design and construction management of streetscape improvements of public infrastructure to Main Street between Illinois Street and Wesley Street, Wheaton Avenue between Liberty Drive and Wesley Street and Liberty Drive from West Street to Hale Street for Streetscape Project Phase 3; and

WHEREAS, Primera Engineering, Ltd. provided professional engineering services for the Streetscape Project Phase 1 and Phase 2; and


WHEREAS, Primera Engineering, Ltd.'s partnership with City staff, professional experience and qualifications and recent performance and quality of work for Phase 1 and Phase 2 was excellent; and

WHEREAS, it is determined by the City that the proposal received from Primera Engineering, Ltd. meets the City's needs; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the City to enter into an agreement with Primera Engineering, Ltd., for the purpose of providing design services to the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Wheaton, Illinois, that the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute and the City Clerk is hereby directed to attest to that a professional services agreement between the City of Wheaton and Primera Engineers, Ltd., Chicago, Illinois, for design services to assist the City with the design and construction management of streetscape improvements of public infrastructure to Main Street between Illinois Street and Wesley Street, Wheaton Avenue between Liberty Drive and Wesley Street and Liberty Drive from West Street to Hale Street for Streetscape Project Phase 3.
