

**RESOLUTION R-2019-45**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A MICROSOFT ON-PREMISE SOFTWARE LICENSE RENEWAL FOR A TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$66,669 THROUGH THE STATE OF ILLINOIS JOINT PURCHASING PROGRAM**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the Illinois Governmental Joint Purchasing Act (30 ILCS 525/1, et seq.), the City may purchase personal property, supplies, and services joining with other governmental units; and Illinois State Statutes authorize municipal governments to jointly purchase supplies; and

**WHEREAS**, the State of Illinois has publicly and competitively bid for Microsoft software products; and


**WHEREAS**, the State of Illinois awarded a contract to CDW Government, LLC. in Vernon Hills, Illinois, for Microsoft software products and has made the contract available to other public entities; and

**WHEREAS**, the corporate authorities of the City of Wheaton find it reasonable and appropriate to purchase a 3-year Microsoft On-Premise Software License Renewal to be paid for at an annual cost of \$22,223 and a total amount not to exceed \$66,669 through the State of Illinois cooperative contract; and

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Wheaton, Illinois, that:

- a) The purchase of a Microsoft On-Premise Software License Renewal through the State of Illinois contract #CMS6945110 with CDW Government, LLC., for a total amount not to exceed \$66,669, as set forth in the itemized quotations that are included in the attached Group Exhibit "A" is hereby authorized (the "Purchase"); and
- b) City staff is authorized to undertake any and all other tasks necessary, or in furtherance of, completion of the Purchase transaction.
