

RESOLUTION R-2019-76

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF AGREEMENT NO. 79 WITH TRIGGI CONSTRUCTION, INC. FOR THE 2019 NEW SIDEWALK PROGRAM FOR A TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$356,264.00

WHEREAS, the corporate authorities of the City of Wheaton, DuPage County, Illinois find it reasonable and appropriate to enter into an agreement with Triggs Construction, Inc., 1975 Powis Road, West Chicago, Illinois, 60186 for the 2019 New Sidewalk Program; and

WHEREAS, the City prepared a bid package (Bid Number 19-67) that included the 2019 New Sidewalk Program; and

WHEREAS, the City budgeted funds in the Capital Projects Fund in the amount of \$355,000.00 for the 2019 New Sidewalk Program; and


WHEREAS, the City solicited bids in a public bidding process and bids were publicly opened and read on July 30, 2019, at 11:00AM and Triggs Construction, Inc. was determined to be the lowest, responsive, responsible bidder; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the City to enter into an agreement with Triggs Construction, Inc. for the 2019 New Sidewalk Program; and

WHEREAS, both parties agree to the terms and conditions set forth in the bid proposal and the agreement contained in the City's bid package for the 2019 New Sidewalk Program.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Wheaton, Illinois, that the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute, and the City Clerk is hereby directed to attest to City of Wheaton Agreement No. 79 with Triggs Construction, Inc., 1975 Powis Road, West Chicago, Illinois, 60186 for the 2019 New Sidewalk Program for a total amount not to exceed \$356,264.00, and that a copy of that certain City of Wheaton Agreement No. 79 is on file with the City Clerk's office and is hereby incorporated into this Resolution as if fully set forth herein.
