

RESOLUTION R-2020-16

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF AGREEMENT NO. 112
WITH ADVANTAGE PAVING SOLUTIONS, INC., FOR THE WATER DIVISION
PARKING LOT IMPROVEMENTS FOR A TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$62,737**

WHEREAS, the corporate authorities of the City of Wheaton, DuPage County, Illinois find it reasonable and appropriate to enter into an agreement with Advantage Paving Solutions, Inc., 20502 S. Cherry Hill Rd., Joliet, Illinois 60433, for the Water Division Parking Lot Improvements; and

WHEREAS, the City prepared a Bid package (Bid Number 20-14) that included the Water Division Parking Lot Improvements; and

WHEREAS, the City solicited bids in a public bidding process and Advantage Paving Solutions, Inc., was determined to be the lowest, responsive, responsible bidder; and


WHEREAS, the City budgeted funds in the Water Fund in the amount of \$75,000 for the Water Division Parking Lot Improvements; and

WHEREAS, both parties agree to the terms and conditions set forth in the Bid and the agreement contained in the City's Bid package for the Water Division Parking Lot Improvements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Wheaton, Illinois, that:



Cherry Hill Rd., Joliet, Illinois 60433, for the Water Division Parking Lot Improvements at the pricing set forth in Advantage Paving Solutions, Inc.'s Fee Proposal, which is incorporated into City of Wheaton Agreement No. 112; and that a copy of that certain City of Wheaton Agreement No. 112 is on file with the City Clerk's office as Exhibit A to this Resolution R-2020-16 and is hereby incorporated into this Resolution as if fully set forth herein.
