

RESOLUTION R-2020-25

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF AGREEMENT NO. 118
WITH WEBSTER, MCGRATH & AHLBERG, LTD., FOR ENGINEERING
SERVICES FOR NEW SIDEWALKS FOR A TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$28,900**

WHEREAS, the corporate authorities of the City of Wheaton, DuPage County, Illinois find it reasonable and appropriate to enter into an agreement with Webster, McGrath & Ahlberg, Ltd., 207 S. Naperville Road, Wheaton, Illinois, 60187, for Engineering Services for New Sidewalks; and

WHEREAS, the City conducted a Request for Proposal (RFP Number 20-24) process and received and reviewed two submittals for engineering services for new sidewalks; and

WHEREAS, Webster, McGrath & Ahlberg, Ltd., submitted a proposal to provide engineering services for new sidewalks in the amount of \$28,900; and

WHEREAS, the City has a satisfactory pre-existing relationship with Webster, McGrath & Ahlberg, Ltd., and its proposal meets the City's needs; and

WHEREAS, the City budgeted funds in the Capital Projects Fund for Engineering Services for New Sidewalks; and

WHEREAS, both parties agree to the terms and conditions set forth in the RFP and the agreement contained in the City's RFP package for Engineering Services for New Sidewalks.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Wheaton, Illinois, that:

The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute, and the City Clerk is hereby directed to attest to City of Wheaton Agreement No. 118, with Webster, McGrath & Ahlberg, Ltd., 207 S. Naperville Road, Wheaton, Illinois, 60187 for Engineering Services for New Sidewalks in an amount not to exceed \$28,900; and that a copy of that certain City of Wheaton Agreement No. 118 is on file with the City Clerk's office as Exhibit A to this Resolution R-2020-25 and is hereby incorporated into this Resolution as if fully set forth herein.
