**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF AGREEMENT NO. 124 WITH  
E. NORMAN SECURITY SYSTEMS, INC. FOR A DOOR SECURITY SYSTEM UPGRADE  
FOR A TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$47,326.76**

**WHEREAS**, the corporate authorities of the City of Wheaton, DuPage County, Illinois find it reasonable and appropriate to enter into an agreement with e.Norman Security Systems, Inc., 1075 Shore Road, Naperville, Illinois, 60101, for a Door Security System Upgrade; and

**WHEREAS**, the City prepared a Bid package (Bid Number 20-48) that included a Door Security System Upgrade; and

**WHEREAS**, the City solicited bids in a public bidding process and e.Norman Security Systems, Inc. was determined to be the lowest, responsive, responsible bidder; and

**WHEREAS**, the City budgeted funds in the Technology Replacement Fund for a total amount of \$25,338.00 for a Door Security System Upgrade. The Technology Replacement Fund has the reserves available to accommodate the additional cost; and

**WHEREAS**, both parties agree to the terms and conditions set forth in the Bid proposal and the agreement for a Door Security System Upgrade.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Wheaton, Illinois, that:

The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute, and the City Clerk is hereby directed to attest to City of Wheaton Agreement No. 124, with e.Norman Security Systems, Inc., 1075 Shore Road, Naperville, Illinois, 60101, for a Door Security System Upgrade for a total amount not to exceed \$47,326.76; and that a copy of that certain City of Wheaton Agreement No. 124 is on file with the City Clerk's office as Exhibit A to this Resolution R-2020-44 and is hereby incorporated into this Resolution as if fully set forth herein.
