

RESOLUTION R-2020-63

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF EMERGENCY VEHICLE UPFITTING
EQUIPMENT FROM FLEET SAFETY SUPPLY FOR A TOTAL AMOUNT
NOT TO EXCEED \$37,707.82**

WHEREAS, the corporate authorities of the City of Wheaton, DuPage County, Illinois find it reasonable and appropriate to enter into a purchase agreement with Fleet Safety Supply, PO Box 649, Naperville, IL 60566, for the purchase of Emergency Vehicle Upfitting Equipment; and

WHEREAS, the City prepared a Bid package (Bid Number 20-75) that included Emergency Vehicle Upfitting Equipment; and


WHEREAS, the City solicited bids in a public bidding process and bids were publicly opened and read on July 31, 2020, at 11:00AM and Fleet Safety Supply was determined to be the lowest, responsive, responsible bidder; and both parties agree to the terms and conditions and pricing set forth in the Bid proposal for Emergency Vehicle Upfitting Equipment; and

WHEREAS, the City has budgeted a total of \$1,480,044 in the Vehicles account (70050) in the Fleet Services Fund for the replacement of vehicles and emergency vehicle upfitting equipment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Wheaton, Illinois, that:

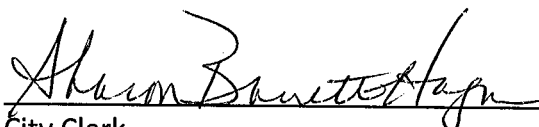
The City's Purchase Order #2021076 for the Emergency Vehicle Upfitting Equipment from Fleet Safety Supply, PO Box 649, Naperville, IL 60566, for a total amount not to exceed \$37,707.82, for the Fleet Division of the Public Works Department is hereby authorized (the "Purchase"); and a copy of the City's Purchase Order #2021076 is on file with the City Clerk's office as Exhibit A to this Resolution R-2020-63 and is hereby incorporated into this Resolution and made a part hereof as if fully set forth herein.
