

**RESOLUTION R-2020-67**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF WATER DIVISION MATERIALS FROM MULTIPLE VENDORS FOR A TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$150,779.64**

**WHEREAS**, the City prepared a Bid package (Bid Number 20-76) that included Water Division Materials; and

**WHEREAS**, the City solicited bids in a public bidding process and bids were publicly opened on August 18, 2020, at 11:00 AM. Bids were evaluated and the lowest price per line item was awarded to each responsive and responsible bidder; and

**WHEREAS**, the City budgeted funds in the CY2020 Water Fund for a total amount of \$143,535.00 for Water Division Materials and reserves are available to accommodate potential additional costs; and


**WHEREAS**, all parties agree to the terms and conditions and pricing set forth in the Bid proposal for Water Division Materials; and

**WHEREAS**, the corporate authorities of the City of Wheaton, DuPage County, Illinois find it reasonable and appropriate to enter into a purchase agreement with multiple vendors for the purchase of Water Division Materials; and


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Wheaton, Illinois, that:

The City's Purchase Orders #2021082, #2021083, #2021084, and #2021085 for the purchase of Water Division Materials from multiple vendors, for a total amount not to exceed \$150,779.64, for the Water Division of the Public Works Department is hereby authorized (the "Purchase"); and City staff is authorized to undertake any and all other tasks necessary, or in furtherance of, completion of the Purchase transaction. A copy of the City's Purchase Orders #2021082, #2021083, #2021084 and #2021085 are on file with the City Clerk's office as Exhibit A to this Resolution R-2020-67 and is hereby incorporated into this Resolution and made a part hereof as if fully set forth herein.
