

RESOLUTION R-2020-71

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF AGREEMENT NO. 142 WITH
AMS MECHANICAL SYSTEMS, INC. FOR A BUILDING AUTOMATION SYSTEM AT
FIRE STATION #38 FOR A TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$31,850**

WHEREAS, the City prepared a Request for Proposal package (RFP Number 20-68) that included a Building Automation System at Fire Station #38; and

WHEREAS, the City solicited proposals in a public bidding process and proposals were evaluated by City staff. It was determined that the proposal received from AMS Mechanical Systems, Inc., for an amount of \$31,850 meets the City's needs; and

WHEREAS, the City has funds available in the Building Renewal Fund in the amount of \$35,969.28 for a Building Automation System at Fire Station #38; and

WHEREAS, both parties agree to the terms and conditions set forth in the RFP and the agreement contained in the City's RFP package for a Building Automation System at Fire Station #38; and

WHEREAS, the corporate authorities of the City of Wheaton, DuPage County, Illinois find it reasonable and appropriate to enter into an agreement with AMS Mechanical Systems, Inc., 9341 Adam Don Parkway, Woodridge, Illinois, 60517, for a Building Automation System at Fire Station #38; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Wheaton, Illinois, that:


The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute, and the City Clerk is hereby directed to attest to City of Wheaton Agreement No. 142, with AMS Mechanical Systems, Inc., 9341 Adam Don Parkway, Woodridge, Illinois, 60517 for a Building Automation System at Fire Station #38 in a total amount not to exceed \$31,850; a copy of that certain City of Wheaton Agreement No. 142 is on file with the City Clerk's office as Exhibit A to this Resolution R-2020-71 and is hereby incorporated into this Resolution as if fully set forth herein.
