

ORDINANCE NO. O-2020-48

AN ORDINANCE MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE CITY OF WHEATON
SPECIAL SERVICE AREA NUMBER THREE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING
JANUARY 1, 2021 AND ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2021

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Wheaton, DuPage County, Illinois, pursuant to its home rule powers, as follows:

Section 1: Findings. The City of Wheaton Special Service Area Number Three has been created by Ordinance No. E-3253, entitled, "An Ordinance Establishing the Wheaton Special Service Area Number Three – Streams (Formerly Known in Part, as Special Service Area Number One)," adopted August 24, 1987, and effective as of August 25, 1987, no petition having been filed opposing the creation of the special service area, pursuant to An Act to provide the manner of levying or imposing taxes for the provision of special services to areas within the boundaries of home rule units and non-home rule municipalities and counties (Public Act 78-901), currently codified as the Special Service Area Tax Law, 35 ILCS 200/27-5 *et seq.* Special Service Area Number Three consists of the territory described in the ordinance aforesaid. The City of Wheaton is now authorized to levy taxes for special services in said special service area.

Section 2: The following sums are hereby appropriated to pay the necessary expenses of Special Service Area Number Three for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2021 and ending December 31, 2021, such appropriations being for the following objects and purposes:




Section 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with these provisions are repealed.
