

RESOLUTION R-2021-80

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF AGREEMENT NO. 221 WITH MAZARINI, INC. FOR CARPET REMOVAL AND REPLACEMENT AT CITY FACILITIES FOR A TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$119,608.62**

**WHEREAS**, the City prepared a bid package (Bid Number 21-87) that included Carpet Removal and Replacement at City Facilities; and

**WHEREAS**, the City solicited bids in a public bidding process and bids were publicly opened and read on July 30, at 11:00 AM. Mazarini, Inc. was determined to be the lowest, responsive, responsible bidder with a bid amount of \$119,608.62; and

**WHEREAS**, the City budgeted funds in the CY2021 Building Renewal Fund for an amount of \$185,500 for Carpet Removal and Replacement at City Facilities; and

**WHEREAS**, both parties agree to the terms and conditions set forth in the bid proposal and the agreement contained in the City's bid package for Carpet Removal and Replacement at City Facilities; and

**WHEREAS**, the corporate authorities of the City of Wheaton, DuPage County, Illinois find it reasonable and appropriate to enter into an agreement with Mazarini, Inc., 100 S. Buffalo Grove Road, Suite 208, Buffalo Grove, Illinois 60089, for Carpet Removal and Replacement at City Facilities.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Wheaton, Illinois, that:

The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute, and the City Clerk is hereby directed to attest to City of Wheaton Agreement No. 221 with Mazarini, Inc., 100 S. Buffalo Grove Road, Suite 208, Buffalo Grove, Illinois 60089, for Carpet Removal and Replacement at City Facilities for a total amount not to exceed \$119,608.62 and that a copy of that certain City of Wheaton Agreement No.221 is on file with the City Clerk's office as Exhibit A to this Resolution R-2021-80 and is hereby incorporated into this Resolution as if fully set forth herein.
