

ORDINANCE NO. O-2022-04

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CALENDAR YEAR 2022 BUDGET
CONTAINED IN ORDINANCE NO. O-2021-57**

WHEREAS, the City of Wheaton has heretofore adopted the Illinois Municipal Budget Law as set out in 65 ILCS 5/8-2-9.1. through 5/8-2-9.10, and as may be qualified by the City's home rule authority under Article VII, Section 6 (i) of the Constitution of the State of Illinois; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Wheaton passed Ordinance No. O-2021-57 adopting the annual budget of the City of Wheaton for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2022 and ending December 31, 2022; and

WHEREAS, said ordinance was filed with the County Clerk of DuPage County in accordance with the applicable State statutes; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to amend the budget contained in Ordinance No. O-2021-57; and

WHEREAS, funds are available to amend the budget for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2022 and ending December 31, 2022; and

WHEREAS, this budget amendment is adopted pursuant to the City of Wheaton's home rule authority.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Wheaton, Illinois:

Section 1. That the expenditure budget of the Capital Equipment Replacement Fund be increased in the amount of \$358,573 in order to amend the following account budget:
