

RESOLUTION R-2022-45

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF AGREEMENT NO. 304 WITH
A LAMP CONCRETE CONTRACTORS, INC. FOR PUBLIC ALLEY RECONSTRUCTION FOR A TOTAL AMOUNT
NOT TO EXCEED \$214,914.25**

WHEREAS, the City prepared a bid package (Bid Number 22-85) that included Public Alley Reconstruction; and

WHEREAS, the City solicited bids in a public bidding process and bids were publicly opened and read on May 20, 2022, at 11:00 AM. A Lamp Concrete Contractors, Inc. was determined to be the lowest, responsive, responsible bidder with a bid amount of \$214,914.25; and

WHEREAS, the City budgeted funds in the CY2022 TIF District #3 fund in an amount of \$95,000 Public Alley Reconstruction and the TIF District #3 fund has the reserves available to accommodate the additional cost; and


WHEREAS, both parties agree to the terms and conditions set forth in the bid proposal and the agreement contained in the City's bid package for Public Alley Reconstruction; and

WHEREAS, the corporate authorities of the City of Wheaton, DuPage County, Illinois find it reasonable and appropriate to enter into an agreement with A Lamp Concrete Contractors, Inc., located at 1900 Wright Boulevard, Schaumburg, Illinois 60193 for Public Alley Reconstruction.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Wheaton, Illinois, that:

The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute, and the City Clerk is hereby directed to attest to City of Wheaton Agreement No. 304 with A Lamp Concrete Contractors, Inc., located at 1900 Wright Boulevard, Schaumburg, Illinois 60193 for Public Alley Reconstruction; and that a copy of that certain City of Wheaton Agreement No. 304 is on file with the City Clerk's office as Exhibit A to this Resolution R-2022-45 and is hereby incorporated into this Resolution as if fully set forth herein.
