

RESOLUTION R-82-05
A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CONTRACT
FOR THE MAINTENANCE OF CARDIAC MONITORS

WHEREAS, the City of Wheaton within the Wheaton Fire Department owns several cardiac monitors for use in the Emergency Medical Services program; and

WHEREAS, these cardiac monitors are critical pieces of equipment used by the paramedics in their care of the residents of the City of Wheaton; and

WHEREAS, the maintenance of these cardiac monitors is essential to the delivery of medical services to our citizenry; and

WHEREAS, Medtronic, Inc. is the manufacturer of this lifesaving equipment and has submitted a quote that is within budget limits for the maintenance of these cardiac monitors.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Wheaton, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1: That Medtronic, Inc. has submitted a five year contract for \$19,575.00 that is payable in annual installments.

Section 2: That formal bidding for the maintenance of the cardiac monitor equipment contained in the 2005-2006 fiscal year budget is hereby waived.

Section 3: That of the amount stated in Section 1, \$19,575.00 will be divided into five equal installments of \$3,915.00 for this fiscal year and each of the next four fiscal years.
